Contract: Parent Agreement Form. Classroom & Behind-the-Wheel

Classroom

The objective of this course is to teach students subject matter relating to the rules of the road, safe driving practices, pedestrian safety, driver responsibility, theory of driving, defensive driving techniques, behavioral characteristics of drivers, auto insurance and financial responsibility, development of perception of driving, emergency procedures, and use of automotive safety devices. The class will consist of lectures, films, handouts, discussions, and reading "Drive Right Textbook" All students are required to bring a notebook, black pen and cell phones must be put away during class. The full course takes a minimum of 4 weeks. Classroom instruction will be given in 15 two-hour sessions, during a minimum period of 4 calendar weeks, with no more than one session a day. Students can only schedule for behind-the-wheel lessons after attending a minimum of 20 hours of classroom instruction and obtaining an instruction permit from the secretary of state. A minimum written test score of 75% is required for successful completion of the classroom portion of the course. Students must also pass the behind the wheel scoring 75% or better.

Behind the wheel training

Students are required to adhere to all applicable road safety rules while participating in driving lessons. This includes but is not limited to: compliance with traffic laws, prohibition of mobile phone use and other obvious distractions while behind the wheel, seat belt usage. Students must carry prescriptions for any medications that they have physician approval to take while driving. Initials _____.

Observation time will be scheduled with each behind-the-wheel session due to the nature of scheduling, state requirements, as well as for additional student learning and engagement. Generally, two (2) students are together for two to three hours in-car instruction. One and a half hours are spent driving, one and a half hours observing by each student. Students who prefer driving sessions privately must obtain written permission from their parents and pay additional fees. Initials _____.

While we understand that your teen may like a particular instructor, students may have a variety of different instructors for behind the wheel training. We cannot guarantee any one instructor. Also, we schedule two students for either a two or three hour behind the wheel training period (for example we set up two students for 8:00 to 11:00 am) , therefore it is common that one student is picked up on time and the other is picked up within 15 minutes of (or shortly after) their scheduled start time. Students may take classroom only, behind the wheel only, or the complete program. It is your responsibility to ensure that your student is enrolling in the correct program- we are available to answer any questions if you are not sure. Extra practice is also available for purchase- inquiries can be directed to the contact information at the end of the contract. Initials _____.

Students must have their original permits with them for each behind-the-wheel lesson to be eligible to drive each session. Students will be denied their scheduled drive if they do not have their permit with them. Initials _____.

Driving Lesson Cancellation Policy

Cancellations with 24+ hours' notice: no penalty

Cancellations less than 24 hours but more than 5 hours before: subject to a fee

No-shows or cancellations with less than 5 hours' notice: **\$50 fee.**
